(ANTI-RAGGING POLICY)

Aim: An educational institution is a temple of holistic learning where learning community enter to grow in wisdom. The basic aim of education is to provide, the youth power, the future of our country, value based and quality-oriented education to achieve this end. It is a primary duty of the all the authorities concerned to build a healthy, congenial and peaceful academic ethos. Hence, there should not be any room for any sort of indiscipline and cases of law and order in the premises. Yet in some of the colleges and universities, a few cases of ragging are reported which vitiate the whole atmosphere and bring a feeling of fear and shame which is absolutely not tolerable and permissible in a civilized society.

It is in this respect that our college also has implemented anti-ragging policy. Discipline and anti-ragging committees of the college continue to focus on the issue so that no such unwanted incident takes place within the campus. Anti-ragging is a great challenging task which Honorable Supreme Court of India and University Grants Commission New Delhi have taken it very seriously and directed to take such measure to curb and control it in such a manner that no such incident takes place within the premises of the institutions.

Under the instructions and guidelines of the Department of Higher Education and the State Government of Madhya Pradesh from time to time, the college administration too has taken this issue seriously knowing its consequences on the lives of students and the status of the college. Anti-ragging committee, Discipline Committee and Women Grievances Redressal Cell have already been active to monitor the activities of the students so that nothing uncalled for happens in the campus of the college. Prohibitory instructions on posters and banners have already been displayed in the college premises. The students are addressed, particularly in the beginning of session and also from time to time, not to indulge in ragging activities as this misconduct spoils the life. However anti-ragging policy is framed after the directions received with reference to UGC letters. Although their multi-mechanism to curb the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, on the recommendations of UGC our college has made following action plan:

1. Constitution of Anti-ragging Committee/cell.
2. Anti-ragging warning displayed at the college campus.
3. Display of banners and posters at certain places in the campus to create awareness on anti-ragging among students.
4. Updating website of institution with complete address and contact details of Nodal Officer and members of the committee.
5. Installation of CCTV cameras at vital points.

COUNSELLING AND MONITORING MEASURES

1. Regular interaction and counselling with the students to detect early signs of ragging and identification of trouble-triggers.
2. Surprise inspection of classrooms, girls' common room, toilets and playgrounds for prevention of any uncalled-for incident.
3. Dissemination of the message of ragging-free campus.

4. Submitting offline affidavit on behalf of students seeking admission .
5. Strict warning to the students for punitive action under the UGC Act against them, in case of any violation of UGC regulations, in this regard.
